# US History: Final Exam Choice Board 

Due: Friday 5/24

- If you have a 4th quarter average of a $\mathbf{9 0 \%}$ OR a FINAL AVERAGE of an $\mathbf{8 5 \%}$ :
- The final is OPTIONAL. You MAY complete one of the finals below to boost your grade.
- If you have a 4th quarter average of a $\mathbf{7 5 \%} \mathbf{0 - 8 9 \%}$, you may complete one of the following:

1. Pick a New Deal Program (Suggested programs: NCCC, WPA, TVA, or the FDIC). Complete a 1 page write up and a poster advertising that program:

- Write up must: explain the Great Depression and its causes; what your selected program did, who it affected and how; if your selected program was effective in providing relief during the Great Depression; explain the design of your poster, who it was meant to appeal to and how. Include works cited with 2 reliable sources cited in MLA. All quotes and paraphrases must be correctly cited.
- Poster must be completed neatly and thoughtfully and reflect the program you researched.

2. Research The Red Scare \& McCarthyism. Complete a 1 page write up and a propaganda poster:

- Write up must: explain the Cold War and its effects on American society; explain the Red Scare, who Joseph McCarthy was and what he did; explain the design of your poster, who it was meant to appeal to and how. Include works cited with 2 reliable sources cited in MLA. All quotes and paraphrases must be correctly cited.
- Poster must be completed neatly and thoughtfully and reflect the topic. Poster must make use of one of the propaganda appeals we covered in class.

3. Create a year-in-review newspaper ( 2 pg . spread) based upon a famous headline from the 20th Century.

- Newspaper will include 3 mini "articles," summarizing 3 major events from the year, a comic or political cartoon, a sports column, and a gossip/horoscope/advice column.

4. If you bring your 4th quarter average above a $90 \%$ (or your final average up to an $85 \%$ ) by submitting late work, you may be exempt. Last day to submit late work, Friday 5/24.

- If you have a 4th quarter average below a 75\%, you must complete:
- An open-book final exam completed after school M 5/20, W $5 / 22$, Th $5 / 23$, or F $5 / 24$.
- If you bring your average above a $75 \%$ by submitting late work, you may complete one of the above assignments. Last day to submit late work, Friday 5/24.
